

Hebrews 4:14-5:10

DFH Worship Translation

^{4:14} So we who have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus, the son of God, let us hold fast to the confession.

¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who, after being tempted similarly in all things, [was] without sin.

¹⁶ So let us approach with confidence to the throne of grace, in order that we might receive mercy and we might find grace in timely help.

^{5:1} For every high priest who has been chosen from men on behalf of men is appointed to the things toward God, in order that he might offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins,

² who is able to moderate his feelings to the ones who are ignorant and to the ones who have been deceived since he also is clothed with weakness,

³ and because of it, he is obligated to offer concerning himself with regard to sins, just as [he is obligated] concerning the people.

⁴ And no one for himself takes the honor, but one who is being called by God just as Aaron [was].

⁵ In this way even Christ did not glorify himself to become high priest but [by] the one who said to him, “You are [the] my son, today I have begotten you,”

⁶ also in another [place] he says, “You [are] a priest into the age according to the order of Melchizedek,”

⁷ who in the days of his flesh, having offered both prayers and supplications to the one who was able to save him out of death, with a mighty cry and tears, and after having been heard because of his reverent awe,

⁸ although he was a son, he learned obedience from what he suffered,

⁹ and, having been made complete, he became [the] source of salvation of the age to all the ones who obey him,

¹⁰ having been designated by God [as] a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.
