

John 21:1-19

DFH Worship Translation

¹ After these things Jesus again revealed himself to the disciples near the Sea of Tiberias; and he revealed [himself] in this manner.

² There were together Simon Peter and Thomas, the one called Twin, and Nathaniel, the one from Cana of Galilee, and the ones of Zebedee and two others from his disciples.

³ Simon Peter said to them, “I am going to fish.” They said to him, “We also are going with you.” They departed and stepped into the boat, and that night they caught nothing.

⁴ Now after it had become early morning, Jesus stood on the shore, though the disciples did not know that it [was] Jesus.

⁵ So Jesus said to them, “Children, do you not have any fish [to eat]?” They answered him, “No.”

⁶ Then he said to them, “Throw the net to the right side of the boat and you will find [fish].” So they threw [the net] and they were no longer able to haul it [in] from the multitude of fish.

⁷ So that disciple whom Jesus was loving said to Peter, “It is the Lord.” So Simon Peter, when he heard that it [was] the Lord, tied around himself an outer garment for he was naked, and he threw himself into the sea.

⁸ And the other disciples came by the boat for they were far away from the land, yet nearly 200 cubits, while dragging the net of fish.

⁹ So when they got out onto the land, they see [a] charcoal [fire] there and cooked fish lying upon [it] and bread.

¹⁰ Jesus said to them, “Bring from the fish which you caught just now.”

¹¹ So Simon Peter went up and hauled the net full of large fish, 153, onto the land, though being so many did not tear apart the net.

¹² Jesus said to them, “Come, eat.” Now not one of the disciples had the courage to question him, “Who are you?”, after having known that it [was] the Lord.

¹³ Jesus comes and takes the bread and gives to them, and the fish in the same way.

¹⁴ This was already [the] third [time] Jesus was revealed to the disciples after being raised from dead.

¹⁵ Then while they ate, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon of John, do you love me more than these?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Herd my lambs.”

¹⁶ He said to him again [a] second [time], “Simon of John, do you love me?” He said to him, “Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.” He said to him, “Shepherd my sheep.”

¹⁷ He said to him the third [time], “Simon of John, do you love me?” Peter was saddened that he said to him the third [time], “Do you love me?” And he said to him, “Lord, you know all things, you know that I love you.” [Jesus] said to him, “Herd my sheep.”

¹⁸ “Amen, Amen, I say to you, when you were young[er] and you were girding yourself and you were going where you wished but when you grow old, you stretch out your hands and another will gird you and carry where you do not wish.”

¹⁹ And he said these things, while explaining by what kind of death he [would] glorify God. And after saying this, he said to him, “Follow me.”
