

Luke 10:1-11, 16-20
DFH Worship Translation

¹ And after these things, the Lord appointed seventy (two) others, and he sent them two by two before his face into every city and place where he was about to go.

² And he said to them, “[The] harvest [is] great, but [the] workers [are] few; therefore ask the lord of the harvest that he might send out workers into his harvest.

³ Go; behold, I send you as lambs [to slaughter] in the midst of wolves.

⁴ Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals, and greet no one along the way.

⁵ Into whatever house you might enter, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’

⁶ And if there is a son of peace there, the peace of you will rest upon him, and if not, it will return to you.

⁷ And remain in the house, eating and drinking things from them; for the worker [is] deserving of his wages. Do not pass over from house to house,

⁸ and if you enter a city and they receive you, eat what they set before you.

⁹ And heal the ones in it [who are] sick and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has drawn near to you.’

¹⁰ And if you enter a city and they do not receive you, go out into its streets and say,

¹¹ ‘Even the dust from your city that has clung to our feet, we wipe off to you. But know this, the kingdom of God has drawn near.’

¹⁶ The one who listens to you, listens to me, and the one who rejects you rejects me; and the one who rejects me, rejects the one who sent me.

¹⁷ And the seventy (two) returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons submit to us in the name of you.”

¹⁸ And he said to them, “I saw Satan falling like lightning from heaven.

¹⁹ Behold, I have given you the authority to tread upon snakes and scorpions and upon all the power of the hostile one, and nothing in any way may harm you.

²⁰ Nevertheless do not rejoice that the spirits have submitted to you, but rejoice that the name of you has been written down in the heavens.”
