

## **Luke 10:25-37**

### **DFH Worship Translation**

<sup>25</sup> And behold a certain expert on the law stood up, testing him, saying, “Teacher, what should I do to inherit eternal life?”

<sup>26</sup> And he said to him, “What has been written in the law? What do you read [there]?”

<sup>27</sup> And he answered and said, “You will love [the] lord your God from the whole heart of you, in the whole soul of you, in the whole strength of you, and in the whole mind of you, and [you will love] your neighbor as yourself.”

<sup>28</sup> And he said to him, “You answered correctly; do that and you will live.”

<sup>29</sup> But desiring to justify himself, he said to Jesus, “And who is my neighbor?”

<sup>30</sup> Jesus replied and said, “A certain man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho and fell among robbers, who after stripping him and striking blows upon [him], went away, leaving [him] half dead.

<sup>31</sup> And by chance a certain priest was going down by that road and, when he saw him, he passed by on the other side.

<sup>32</sup> And likewise a Levite also [happened] upon the place; when he came and saw [him], he passed by on the other side.

<sup>33</sup> And a certain Samaritan who was traveling came upon him, and when he saw [him], he was stirred with pity.

<sup>34</sup> And he approached and bound up his wounds, pouring on olive oil and wine, and after putting him upon his own pack animal, he led him to an inn and he attended to him.

<sup>35</sup> And on the next day, he took out and gave two denarii to the innkeeper, saying ‘Attend to him, and whatever you spend in addition, I will give back to you when I return.’

<sup>36</sup> Which of these three seems to you to be a neighbor to the one who fell into the robbers?”

<sup>37</sup> And he said, “The one who did mercy for him.” And Jesus said to him, “Go and do likewise.”
