

## **Luke 12:32-40**

### **DFH Worship Translation**

<sup>32</sup> Fear not, little flock, because your father has taken pleasure to give you the kingdom.

<sup>33</sup> Sell your possessions and give alms; make for yourselves purses that do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that never gives out, that neither a thief draws near nor a moth destroys;

<sup>34</sup> for where your treasure is, there also your heart will be.

<sup>35</sup> Keep your loins girded and your lamps burning.

<sup>36</sup> And you [should be] like those who wait for their master whenever he might return from the feasts, so that when he comes and knocks, at once they open [the door] [for] him.

<sup>37</sup> Blessed [are] those slaves whom he will find awake when he returns. Amen, I say to you, he will gird his loins and he will make them recline [as guests at a meal] and he will come beside and deacon them.

<sup>38</sup> And if he comes in the second or third watch, blessed are those he finds in this way.

<sup>39</sup> But know this: if the master of the house knew [the] hour in which the thief was coming, then he [would] not allow [him] to break into his house.

<sup>40</sup> And you must be ready because the Son of Man is coming in an hour you are not expecting.
