¹ Now some were present at the same time, reporting to him concerning the Galileans, whose blood Pilate mixed with their sacrifices.

² And he answered and said to them, “Do you believe these Galileans became sinners beyond all the Galileans because they suffered these things?”

³ No, I tell you, but unless you [all] repent, likewise you all will perish.

⁴ Or those 18 on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them; do you believe that they became debtors beyond all men dwelling in Jerusalem?”

⁵ No, I tell you, but unless you [all] repent, likewise you all will perish.”

⁶ Then he told them this parable, “Someone had a fig tree, which had been planted in his vineyard, and he came, looking for fruit on it and he did not find [any].

⁷ Then he said to the gardener, ‘Behold, I have been coming three years, looking for fruit on this fig tree, and I do not find [any]. So cut it down. Why is it wasting the soil?’

⁸ Then he answered and said to him, ‘Master, leave it alone also this year until I dig around it and throw manure [on it];

⁹ and if indeed it produces fruit in the future, . . . , if not, you will cut it down.’”
