

## **Luke 17:5-10**

### **DFH Worship Translation**

<sup>5</sup> And the apostles said to the Lord, “Add faith to us.”

<sup>6</sup> And the Lord said, “If you have faith like a seed of a mustard plant, you would say to the sycamore tree, ‘Be uprooted and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you.

<sup>7</sup> And who among you, who has a slave who is plowing or herding a flock, after coming in from the field, would say to him, ‘Come beside [me] and rest,’

<sup>8</sup> rather, will he not say to him, ‘Prepare something that I might eat, and after girding yourself, deacon me while I eat and drink, and after these things, you may eat and drink.’

<sup>9</sup> Do you have favor for a slave because he did that which he was ordered?

<sup>10</sup> So also to you, when you might do all the things which were ordered to you, you say, ‘We are slaves who are owed nothing; what we were indebted to do, we have done.’”
