¹ He entered Jericho and was passing through it.

² And behold, a man by name called Zacchaeus, and he was a head tax collector and he [was] rich;

³ and he was seeking to see who Jesus was, and he was not able from the crowd because he was small of stature.

⁴ And he ran ahead to the front and climbed upon a sycamore tree in order that he might see him because he was about to pass through that [way].

⁵ And as he came to the place and looked up, Jesus said to him, “Zacchaeus, hurry and come down, for today it is necessary for me to stay in your house.”

⁶ And after he hurried and came down, he rejoiced and welcomed him.

⁷ Now after seeing these things, all were grumbling, saying, “With a sinful man he entered to stop [for the night].”

⁸ Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, “Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I give to the begging poor, and if I extort from anyone, I give back four times.”

⁹ Then Jesus said to him, “Today, salvation has come about to this house because he, too, is a son of Abraham,

¹⁰ for the Son of Man came to seek out and to save what has been lost.”
