²⁶ Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee, to which the name was Nazareth,

²⁷ to a teenage girl, who had become betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph from the house of David, and the name of the girl was Mary.

²⁸ He approached her and said, “Rejoice, favored one, the Lord [is] with you”;

²⁹ but she was confused by this message and was pondering what sort of greeting this might be.

³⁰ Then the angel said to her, “Fear not, Mary, for you [have] found favor in the sight of God.

³¹ And behold, you will conceive in your womb and you will give birth to a son, and you will call his name Jesus.

³² He will be great and will be called Son of [the] Most High and the Lord God will give him the throne of David, his father,

³³ and he will rule over the house of Jacob into the ages, and there will be no end of his rule.”

³⁴ But Mary said to the angel, “How will this be, since I do not know a man?”

³⁵ The angel answered and said to her, “[The] Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of [the] Most High will cast a shadow over you; therefore the one who is begotten holy will be called the Son of God.

³⁶ And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, she also has conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month to her, who is called barren.

³⁷ For every word from God will not be impossible.”

³⁸ Then Mary said, “Behold, the servant of the Lord; may it be done to me, according to your word.” Then the angel departed from her.
