⁶⁷ Then Zechariah, his father, was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied, saying:

⁶⁸ “Blessed [be] [the] Lord, the God of Israel, because he visited and brought about the release of his people,

⁶⁹ and he raised up for us a horn of deliverance by the house of David, his servant,

⁷⁰ just as he spoke through the mouth of the holy ones from [the] age, his prophets,

⁷¹ deliverance from our enemies and from the hand of all those who hate us;

⁷² to do mercy among our fathers, to remember his holy covenant,

⁷³ an oath which he swore to Abraham, our father, to grant us,

⁷⁴ having been delivered from the hand of our enemies, to worship him fearlessly

⁷⁵ in holiness and righteousness before him all our days.

⁷⁶ And you, also, child, will be called a prophet of the Most High, for you will go before the Lord to prepare his ways,

⁷⁷ to give knowledge of deliverance to his people by cancellation of their sins,

⁷⁸ through tender mercies of our God, the rising from on high will visit us,

⁷⁹ to give light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide our feet in the way of peace.”
