²⁴ But in those days after that oppression, the sun will be darkened and the moon will not give its light,

²⁵ and the stars will be falling out of heaven and the powers, the ones in the heavens, will be shaken.

²⁶ And then they will see the Son of Man coming on clouds with great power and glory.

²⁷ And then he will send the angels and he will gather together his chosen ones out of the four winds, from the top of earth up to the top of heaven.

²⁸ And from the fig tree learn the parable; by the time its branch becomes tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near.

²⁹ In this way also, when you might see these things take place, know that [he] is near, at [the] gates.

³⁰ Truly I tell you that this generation certainly will not pass away until all these things take place.

³¹ The heaven and the earth will pass away but my words certainly will not pass away.

³² But about that day or the hour no one knows, neither the angels in heaven nor the son, [no one] except the father.

³³ Watch out, keep your eyes open, for you do not know when the time is.

³⁴ As a man [going] away on a journey leaves his household and gives authority to his servants, to each his work, and he commands the doorkeeper in order that he might stay awake.

³⁵ Therefore stay awake for you do not know when the master of the household is coming, either late in the day or in the middle of the night or at the crowing of the cock or early in the morning,

³⁶ or else he might come suddenly and find you sleeping.

³⁷ And what I say to you, I say to everyone, stay awake.
