²² And straight away he pressed the disciples to get into a boat and to go before him to the other side until he could send away the crowds.

²³ And after he sent away the crowds, he went up the mountain by himself to pray. And when it became late, he was alone there.

²⁴ And the boat already was distant many stadia from the land, when it was tormented from the waves, for it was opposite the wind.

²⁵ And in the fourth watch of the night, he came toward them, walking upon the sea.

²⁶ And the disciples were shaken when they beheld him walking upon the sea, saying, "It is an apparition," and they cried out from fear.

²⁷ And straight away Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Have courage, it is I; do not be afraid."

²⁸ And Peter answered him and said, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come toward you upon the waters."

²⁹ And he said, "Come." And after Peter climbed down from the boat, he walked upon the waters and went toward Jesus.

³⁰ And when he saw the strong wind, he was afraid, and when he began to sink, he cried out and said, "Lord, save me."

³¹ And immediately Jesus stretched out his hand and took hold of him and said to him, "One of little faith, why did you doubt?"

³² And when they climbed up into the boat, the wind stopped.

³³ And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are God's son."

³⁴ And after crossing over, they came to the land at Gennesaret.

³⁵ And after the men of that place recognized him, they sent out into all the region around and brought to him all those having diseases,

³⁶ and they implored him that they might only touch the hem of his cloak, and as many as he touched were brought safely through.
