¹ When he beheld the crowds, he climbed up the mountain, and after he sat down, his disciples came to him;

² and he opened his mouth and taught them, saying,

³ “Blessed [are] the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of the heavens.

⁴ Blessed [are] those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

⁵ Blessed [are] the gentle, for they will inherit the earth.

⁶ Blessed [are] those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be satisfied.

⁷ Blessed [are] the merciful, for they will receive mercy.

⁸ Blessed [are] the pure of heart, for they will see God.

⁹ Blessed [are] the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.

¹⁰ Blessed [are] those who have been persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of the heavens.

¹¹ Blessed [are] you [plural] when they mock you and persecute you and say every evil, telling lies against you because of me.

¹² Rejoice and be glad that your compensation in the heavens [is] great, for in this way they persecuted the prophets before you.
