

## **Romans 6:1-11**

### **DFH Worship Translation**

<sup>1</sup> What then shall we say? Should we remain in sin in order that grace might abound?

<sup>2</sup> May it not be so! How can we who died to sin still live in it?

<sup>3</sup> Or do you not know that as many as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

<sup>4</sup> So we were buried with him through baptism into death in order that just as Christ was raised from [the] dead through the glory of the father, so we too might walk in newness of life.

<sup>5</sup> For if we have become grafted together in the likeness of his death, we also will be [together] in the resurrection.

<sup>6</sup> Knowing this, that our old person was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be done away with, we no longer serve sin.

<sup>7</sup> For the one who died has been justified from sin;

<sup>8</sup> but if we died with Christ, we trust that we also will live with him.

<sup>9</sup> We know that Christ, after being raised from [the] dead, no longer dies; death no longer is master of him.

<sup>10</sup> For the [death] he died, he died to sin once for all, but the [life] he lives, he lives to God.

<sup>11</sup> In this way you too should reckon yourselves to be dead to sin [and] living to God in Christ Jesus.
